Vigilance on encephalitis needed

Sept. 13, 2010 (AP): Michigan Health officials are reminding people to be vigilant about taking steps to prevent the spread of *Eastern equine encephalitis* in Michigan. The disease is rare but can be deadly among humans. Last month, Michigan health officials reported that lab tests confirmed that three people contracted the disease. Health officials say people should take steps to avoid being bitten by mosquitoes and horses should be vaccinated.

Fridays, October 1, 8, 15, 22, 6–9 p.m. – Sugar Skulls: Decorate your own sugar skull and learn how they are used for Day of the Dead celebrations in Mexican and Mexican American communities.

Friday, October 29, 6–9 p.m., Saturday and Sunday, October 30, and 31, Noon-4 p.m. - Halloween Masks: Make a spooky or kooky Halloween mask using tag board, markers, beads, and other art-making material.

Saturday, October 2, 9, 16, 23, Noon–4.p. m. – *Parfleche*: A parfleche is a type of carrying case used by Native American Plains Indians. Use brown paper, leather

cord and markers to make your own miniature version.
Sundays, October 3, 10, 17, 24, Noon–4 p.m. – *Tibetan Prayer Flags*: Learn how Tibetan prayer flags are made and used while you create your own personal flag to take home.
